

Submission of abstracts

The scientific committee invites you to participate actively in this congress, which will be an extraordinary occasion for the exchange of thoughts and experiences. We look forward to receiving abstracts online for consideration and inclusion in the scientific programme as oral or E-Poster. Please note that abstracts can only be presented on-site including accepted E-Posters, not virtually! Please ensure that you are able to travel to Alexandria when submitting an abstract.

All abstracts will be reviewed by members of the scientific committee. All accepted abstracts will be published online on the congress website as an abstract book. There will be no printed version of the abstract book.

The abstract submission will be available on 1st of April 2025.
The deadline for abstract submissions is 1st August 2025.

Guidelines for preparation of abstracts

- Please choose a title that clearly indicates the content of the contribution.
- Please avoid abbreviations in the title (exception: scientific terms).
- Abbreviations may be used in the text if they are defined when used first.
- Please make sure to use proper English language.
- Please refrain from spelling abstract titles and co-authors' names in CAPITAL LETTERS or in lower case (e.g., FIRST NAME LAST NAME or first name last name).
- The author's name (full first name, family name) and place of work (institution, city, country) should be indicated in the respective form fields, not in the abstract title.

Guidelines for submission of abstracts

- A maximum of 5 abstracts per author will be accepted for submission. Additional submissions will not be considered (without further notice).
- The author should submit her/his work and is considered to present it on-site in Alexandria. Therefore, submissions on behalf of other authors cannot be accepted.
- The abstract should meet one of the following Pathology disciplines:
 - Gynecologic and breast pathology
 - Cytopathology
 - Neuropathology
 - Genitourinary pathology
 - GIT and pancreaticobiliary pathology
 - Bone and soft tissue pathology
 - AI in pathology
 - Molecular, cytogenetics, and immunohistochemistry in surgical pathology.
- An abstract which has been previously published cannot be submitted, unless there are new methods, findings, updated data or other acceptable reasons for submitting.

- Abstracts are to be submitted in English, the official language of the 36th IAP-AD congress, should not exceed 300 words (in total; there is no limit per field) and be structured in the following specified subtitles: background & objective, methods, results and conclusion.
- Case reports should also be structured as much as possible following the aforementioned categories. If not possible, the authors should upload the abstracts using the most appropriate categories (in the respective text boxes in the submission form).
- Changes in authorship should be communicated to the IAP-AD at info@iapadegypt2025.com in order to ensure correct appearance in the printed programme.
- Should the submitting author, who is considered the presenter, turn out to be unable to present her / his poster, one of the co-authors should take over this responsibility. A change of the presenting author needs to be communicated to the IAP-AD scientific committee at info@iapadegypt2025.com and will only be processed after acceptance of abstracts. Presenter changes, which are being addressed to the scientific committee before the official acceptance notification, will not be considered.
- Registration to the congress and payment of the respective fee is mandatory to be able to present the abstract and get it published in the abstract book – and must be completed by 1st September 2025. If the speaker fails to register and pay before this date, her / his abstract will be excluded from the scientific programme.
- The acceptance of abstracts by the scientific committee does not imply any financial assistance or fee reduction.
- Notification of acceptance or rejection by the scientific committee will be emailed to the submitting author. Detailed information in which format the abstract is accepted (oral or E-Poster), guidelines and recommendations for each abstract type as well as time allotment, date, hour, and venue will be sent in due time to registered presenting authors.
- Abstract PRESENTING authors may register at the early registration fee by 1st July 2025 (DATE OF EARLY BIRD). If no registration has been submitted by that date, the early registration fee will be made available again once abstract notifications have been sent out, up until 1st September 2025. This option is only available to the submitting PRESENTING author and not for the rest of coauthors.
